A Note on Alagappa University

Alagappa University is located at Karaikudi in Tamil Nadu is accessible from Madurai and Tiruchirappalli Airports within two hours. The 440 acre green and lush campus houses all the academic activities. This University has emerged from the galaxy of institutions initially founded by the great philanthropist and educationist Dr. RM. Alagappa Chettiar. Alagappa University was brought into existence by a Special Act of the Government of Tamil Nadu in May 1985 with the objective of fostering research, development and dissemination of knowledge in various branches of learning. Alagappa University is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India. The University has 44 Departments, 3 Academic Centres, 2 Constituent Colleges (AUCE, AUCPE) on its campus & 45 Affiliated Colleges. The University's motto is "Excellence in Action" and the University keeps before it the vision of excellence in all spheres of its action.

The Centre for Women's Studies of Alagappa University was established in 1988 as the first University Grants Commission approved Centre in Tamil Nadu. About the Capacity Building Programme

Women academicians all over the world are under-represented in the higher education system. The participation of women in key committees in the University and decision-making process continues to be low, which is one of the major factors leading to under-representation of women in management positions. It is, therefore, essential to build a critical mass of trained women, competent to hold senior administrative positions and to facilitate the process of removing gender barrier that has persisted despite women acquiring higher education. Several factors have led to the disadvantaged position of women in society at large, which has affected the culture of the higher education system. In spite of the Constitutional rights extended to women from the time India became Republic and by signing of the UN Convention on the Rights of Women signed in 1993 by the Government of India, still women academicians are facing gender barriers that prevent them to attain a higher position. To meet the challenge, it is necessary to offer training programmes to women for capacity building to become managers in order to participate in policy, decision making, ensuring gender sensitivity in governance and administration of the University and in Colleges.

Aim of the Programme

- To increase the participation of women in higher education management for better gender balance
- To provide awareness on policies and procedures, which recognise women's equity and diversity, and facilitate conducive environment for their development
- To develop a strategy for reducing the gender gap in the higher education system
- To support gender positive initiatives in the higher education system such as gender equity cell, Gender Budget Cell, and ICC

Who can Register?

This Programme is open to teaching faculties of all disciplines working in Colleges and Universities in India. The intake is subject to increase in exceptional cases. However, the selection of participants will be done as per the UGC guidelines. The CBP is intended to Social Science (Economics, Commerce, Management, Sociology, Anthropology, Social Work, Psychology, Education, Political Science, Public Administration, Law, History, Geography, Library and Information Science, Mass Communication and allied social science disciplines) faculty members of any UGC recognized University/College/Institution engaged in teaching and research.
